AIM:

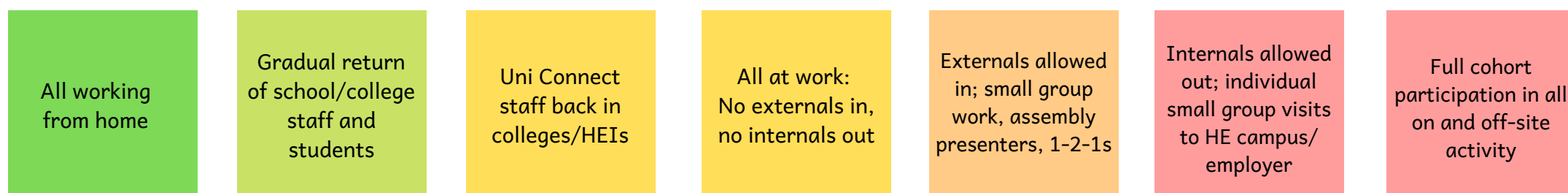
In light of the current Covid-19 pandemic, to work with schools and colleges to:
